- * Those swimmers that wish to participate in YMCA Districts, States, and Nationals must be YMCA members. **All memberships must be obtained by December 1, 2010.** NYAC swimmers that are YMCA members may also use the YMCA at any time, and take advantage of any extra practices at the YMCA. If you only wish to swim in the local league meets (CPAL) and Divisionals/All-Stars, you do NOT need to be a member of the YMCA
- ** Those swimmers that would like to take part in USA Swimming invitationals (**WSY will be hosting 3**), and become members of USA swimming should add the yearly registration fee to their totals. - *** Monthly payments are made by bank draft or credit card. If paying monthly, the first payment is due at the time of registration (which represents your September/October payment), at which time you will fill out the credit card authorization form for the remaining payments. The remaining payments (November, December, January, February) will be deducted from your account by the 15th of each month.
- **** **All 2010-2011 Registration forms must be returned and fees paid by Friday, October 22, 2010. We will hold two NYAC Registration evenings at the pool prior to this date.**

At the time of registration you will pay your first month's payment (representing the September/October payment), and a \$100 per family administrative fee. This is a yearly fee, and there will not be a separate administrative fee for the Summer of 2011. This fee will go to help with the cost of ribbons for swim meets, end of year banquet, coach's travel, and custodial fees for home swim meets. All fees must be paid either "in-full" or by monthly draft.

High School is for High School swimmers that will practice 90% of the High School Season (November 19 – February 11, 2011) with their High School team. There is no separate practice group for this level. This is for financial purposes. Swimmers selecting this payment plan would have the opportunity to attend NYAC practices on average of once per week, plus meets during the Fall/Winter season.
